The Emeritus Academy provides a way to recognize and promote the ongoing engagement of Penn State emeriti faculty in scholarly and creative activities. Applications to the Academy are accepted year-round.

Those selected for participation in the Emeritus Academy will be granted the title Academy Professor for their three-year term of membership, with the possibility of renewal. Academy members are expected to be actively involved and productive in an area of research or creative activity that is consistent with the University's academic mission.
